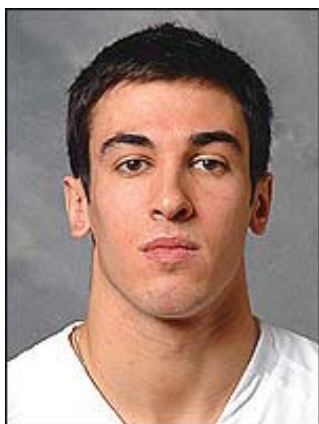

TOP 10 POLL #1

February 12, 2007

JERSEY CITY, NJ...A familiar face can be found at the top of the first NECVA poll of the 2007 season, as Stevens garnered 10 of 12 first place votes and received 118 of 120 possible points. The Ducks were the No. 1 ranked team in the conference for 18 consecutive polls before being upset in the 2006 NECVA Tournament. Nazareth College has defeated its top three rivals in the Western Division, and the Golden Flyers have earned their highest ranking in school history at No. 2, after winning its own tournament last weekend. The same can be said about Massachusetts Institute of Technology. MIT, which at 14-1 has the best overall record in the league, received two first place votes after taking the title of its tournament last weekend. The No. 3 ranking is the highest ever for the Engineers. Eastern Mennonite is ranked fourth after finishing 3-1 at the Nazareth Invitational, and D'Youville College, which also went 3-1 at the tournament, losing in the finals to Nazareth, comes in at No. 5.

Medaille is ranked No. 6, while SUNY-New Paltz, which went 2-2 at the Nazareth Invitational, is seventh. The Hawks are 4-1 in the NECVA Metro Division. Ramapo College is also 4-1 in the Metro, and the Roadrunners, at No. 8, are the highest ranked team in the NECVA that is not among the Top 15 in the national poll. Rivier College, the defending conference champions, had won five of six to rebound nicely from a 1-4 start to the season. The Raiders are No. 9 in the poll—their lowest ranking in the four-year history of the poll. Vassar College is not eligible for the NECVA Tournament this year as an affiliate member of the league, but they make their first-ever appearance in the Top 10 poll. At No. 10, the Brewers are 4-2 against NECVA opponents.

Four other teams received a number of votes, led by Newbury College with nine, just two behind Vassar. Philadelphia Biblical is off to a 10-2 start and also received nine points, while New Jersey City University took home eight points with an 8-4 mark. Hunter College is the lone representative of the CUNYAC Division, with six points.

ABOUT THE NECVA:

The North East Collegiate Volleyball Association, the largest known single-sport conference in the United States, is in its 13th year of competition during the 2007 season as a leading Division III men's volleyball conference. Founded in 1995 as the Metro Conference, it became known as the NECVA in 1998. Currently comprised of 36 colleges and universities stretching from New Hampshire to Virginia, Vassar College joined the league this year as an affiliate member, and will become a member of the Metro Division in 2008.

The league is divided into four smaller divisions: CUNY (8), Metro (8), New England (12), and Western (7), with one associate member. Each week, coaches from the four divisions nominate athletes and then vote for the divisional Player and Rookie of the Week awards. The conference sports information office then selects the NECVA Player and Rookie honors from each of these four divisional winners.

The NECVA holds an annual 16-team conference tournament each April with the top three schools in each division and four at-large selections earning berths. The NECVA champion receives one of four automatic bids to the Molten Division III Final Four in April.

CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

TOM MAVING • NAZARETH COLLEGE

JR • OH • Tonawanda, NY/Canisius HS

Tom Maving is the first Nazareth player ever named NECVA Conference Player of the Week, and became the first Golden Flyer ever named Sports Imports/AVCA Division III Men's National Player of the Week. The Most Valuable Player of the Nazareth Invitational, he tallied 4.72 points, 4.22 kills, 1.44 digs and hit .477 overall (76-14-130) as Nazareth (12-3, 5-0 NECVA) won all four of their matches in the tournament, including two wins over ranked teams. He also helped the Flyers knock off nationally ranked Medaille earlier in the week. Maving, a 6-foot-11 hitter, had some of his best matches against ranked opponents. In the sweep of Medaille on February 6, he hit .524 with 14 kills (14-3-21), five digs and two blocks. He had a .529 percentage in a sweep of Ramapo, with 10 kills (10-1-17), and posted 18 winners (18-4-32) and a .438 percentage with nine digs and four blocks in a 3-2 win over Eastern Mennonite. In a sweep of Vassar, he totalled 12 kills and a .409 attack rate (12-3-22). In the finals of the tournament on February 10, he planted 22 kills with only three errors (22-3-38), hit .500, and chipped in six digs and two blocks in a 3-1 win over D'Youville. He currently ranks 13th in the NECVA in hitting percentage (.353), 18th in kills (3.58), and 29th in points (4.01).

CUNYAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

VELISLAV DANAILOV • HUNTER COLLEGE

Velislav Danailov is the CUNYAC Player of the Week after the sophomore gave the Hawks a lift in his first action of the season, averaging 10.50 assists in a 3-0 week. He compiled six aces, 29 assists and three solo blocks in a 3-0 win at Lehman on February 6. The 6-4 setter followed that up with 31 assists and seven kills against City Tech in another sweep on February 10, finishing the week with 24 assists, five kills, and a two solo blocks against Medgar Evers in the second 3-0 match win of the day.

METRO PLAYER OF THE WEEK

MAURICE WASHINGTON • NEW JERSEY CITY

SR • S • Orlando, FL/Edgewater HS

Maurice Washington is the NECVA Metro Player of the Week for the third time in his career after becoming NJCU's all-time leader in assists, now with 3,921 and counting, as he led NJCU to a 4-1 week on the court. In the 14 games he played setter, he averaged exactly 11 assists per game. With NJCU defeating Yeshiva in the first match of a doubleheader on Sunday, he played the second game as an outside hitter. Overall in 17 games, he averaged 9.06 assists, 1.59 kills, 2.18 digs and 0.71 aces per game. He hit .310 overall. In NJCU's 3-0 sweep of CCNY he provided 41 assists, seven digs and three aces. In a 3-2 neutral court win over Villa Julie, Washington had 56 assists, six digs, five blocks and four aces. In a 3-0 loss to Philadelphia Biblical, he provided 32 assists and nine digs. The 32 assists allowed him to pass Arvin Rada's 10-year-old school record for career assists (3,904, 1995-97).

NEW ENGLAND PLAYER OF THE WEEK

TIM HUGHES • MOUNT IDA COLLEGE

SR • MB • Holliston, MA/Holliston HS

Tim Hughes is the New England Division Player of the Week after record a career-best 44 kills while leading the Mustangs to a 3-2 win over Polytechnic at the MIT Invitational, to snap the team's 12-match winning streak. Overall in five match and 21 games, he had a tremendous statistical week, averaging 7.86 points, 6.71 kills, 1.24 digs, 0.86 blocks and 0.48 aces per game while hitting .383. He had 25 or more kills in four matches with 141 total. In a 3-1 loss to Johnson and Wales, he collected 28 kills (28-10-42), hit .429, and added three blocks. In a 3-0 loss to MIT, the 6-foot-4 middle had 11 kills and three blocks. He finished with 26 kills (26-11-53, .283), with eight digs, two aces and five blocks in a 3-1 loss to Mount Saint Vincent and added 32 kills (32-9-61), seven digs, five blocks and three aces with a .377 percentage in a 3-2 loss to Bard. In the Polytechnic match, he had 44 kills and hit .481 (44-6-79), adding four aces and two blocks. He currently leads the NECVA in kills (6.10) and points per game (7.22), and ranks 15th in hitting percentage (.340) and 19th in aces (0.49).

Michael Townsend is the NECVA Conference Rookie of the Week as he was named to the All-Tournament Team at the MIT Invitational and averaged 4.64 points, 3.95 kills, 2.52 digs and 0.43 aces. Townsend was instrumental in the Saints 3-1 win over #14 Newbury, as he collected 19 kills, 14 digs and two aces. The 5-foot-8 hitter had 12 kills, 11 digs and two aces in a 3-1 loss to Rivier. He combined for 23 kills, four aces and three blocks in a pair of sweeps over Polytechnic and Lasell, before again tallying 19 kills, with eight digs and two aces in a 3-1 loss to New Haven. He collected 10 digs with two blocks in a 3-0 loss to MIT. On the year, he ranks tied for 14th in aces (0.48), 15th in points (4.43), 16th in the league in kills (3.75), and 31st in digs (2.61).

CUNYAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

SALOMON RAMOS • CITY TECH

FR • OH • Staten Island, NY/Tottenville HS

Salomon Ramos is the CUNYAC Rookie of the Week after he averaged 3.5 kills and 2.5 digs in three conference matches last week. The 5-foot-9 outside hitter, who hit a spectacular .415 from the floor, opened the week with 16 kills and 10 digs against in a 3-1 loss to Brooklyn College on February 6. On February 10, he posted 15 kills and had a .667 hitting percentage as the Yellow Jackets snapped a 12-match losing streak with a 3-0 sweep of York. He added 10 digs in a 3-0 loss to Hunter on February 10. He currently ranks fifth in the league with a .415 hitting percentage, 20th in kills and 34th in points per game.

METRO ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

JOSE SILVA • NEW JERSEY CITY

Jose Silva is the NECVA Metro Division Rookie of the Week after the 6-foot-3 middle blocker helped the Gothic Knights to a 4-1 week. He had a .425 hitting percentage with averages of 3.00 points, 2.35 kills, 1.29 digs and 0.76 blocks per game. In a 3-0 win over CCNY he hit .750 (7-1-8) with three blocks, and provided 10 kills, three blocks and a .400 percentage in a 3-2 win against Villa Julie. He nearly tallied a double-double in a sweep of Yeshiva, providing nine kills, 10 digs, two solo blocks and a .412 percentage. He notched 10 kills, eight digs, and three aces with a .421 attack rate in NJCU's second 3-0 win over Yeshiva. He currently ranks 16th in the league in blocking at 1.14 per game.
