The Bloodhounds' third baseman came up big as John Jay took two of three contests in their first-place showdown with Mitchell. The Bronx native, who hit .533 (8-for-15) last week, went 6-for-7 and drove in six runs in the two victories. The senior also went 2-for-5 with three RBI's and picked up the win as he hurled a pair of scoreless frames in relief. The St. Raymond's graduate drove in a total of nine runs over the four contests. He's now batting .406 on the season and has driven in 19 runs.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK

The senior overpowered John Jay as Mitchell salvaged their key three-game series with CUNYAC leader John Jay on April 22nd. The south-paw went the distance, allowing just one run on three hits in a 9.0 inning masterpiece. The Prospect, Connecticut native had Bloodhounds' hitters shaking their heads the entire afternoon, fanning 12 batters and allowing just one free pass. The Wolcott graduate is now 3-1 with a 3.64 ERA, and has 51 strikeouts in 37.1 innings of work.

The right fielder batted .571(8-for-14) and had three multiple-hit contests in Mitchell's 2-2 week. The two-sport star hit safely in all six contests last week as the Dolphins won six conference games. The First Team CUNYAC All-Star (basketball) hit an even .500 (10-for-20), drove in five runs, and scored seven times. She has now has hit safely in 11 of her last 13 games and is batting .300 on the season. The Brooklyn native went 3-for-7 versus Hunter (4/19), 5-for-8 (4 RBI) against Lehman (5-for-8), and finished 2-for-5 versus Baruch (4/22). The Bishop Kearney also swiped four bases and now leads the team with six stolen bases.

The senior recorded the win in four of Staten Island's six contests to improve to 7-4 on the season. The Staten Island native allowed just three earned runs and 13 hits in 17.0 innings of work to lower her CUNYAC leading ERA to 1.36. The Moore graduate, who fanned 21 batters last week, pitched complete-game shutouts against Hunter (4/19) and Baruch (4/22). In addition, she earned relief wins against Hunter and Lehman.

The Bronx native is the CUNYAC Rookie of the Week for the second straight time after batting .529 (9-for-17) with seven RBI's last week. The freshman went 3-for-4 with a homer and three RBI's in the Bearcats 10-2 victory at Brooklyn (4/17). The catcher/shortstop also went 3-for-7 with four runs and three RBI's in the sweep of John Jay (4/19), and finished up the week by going 3-for-6 in a losing cause to Staten Island (4/22). The Aquinas product raised her average to .487 on the season and also leads the team with 27 RBI's.
